



Silver State Girls Soccer League Intra-Club Player Policy

All teams playing in Silver State Girls Soccer League will be allowed intra-club players for league games under the following guidelines:

- ✓ Intra-club players must be registered with USYSNV (NYSA) within the same club as the team they will be playing for.
- ✓ **Intra-club players can only play for one team per day.**
- ✓ A maximum of **5** intra-club players can be used for any U11 or above game; a maximum of **3** intra-club players can be used for any U10 and below game.
- ✓ Intra-club players must not be older than the team they are playing for according to birthdates used by USYSNV (NYSA).

The coach using an intra-club player is to present the intra-club player's pass to officials at check-in. Intra-club player's names are to be written on the game cards by the Referee, along with their original team name. Coaches / Managers should not tamper with or alter the official game card in any way.

When a coach is lending an intra-club player, that player's name is to be crossed off their game card if they have a game the same day. If not, disciplinary action can be taken against both teams as it will be assumed the player played in both games.

No games will be rescheduled due to a team not having enough players. **If a team uses intra-club player(s), it is an official GotSoccer forfeit with a 1 – 0 score for the other team, however, the game will be played and the unofficial score of the match should also be noted on the game card.**
